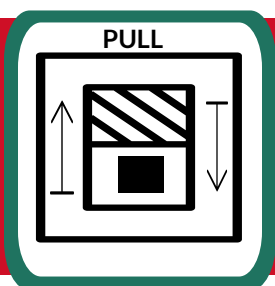


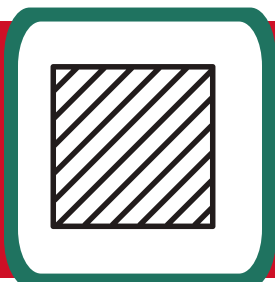
Maintaining The Fire Alarm/Smoke Detector



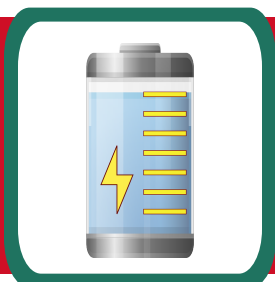
If a fire alarm or smoke detector goes off, it can create panic among the family members. So, make sure that you are always prepared for such a situation.



Properly test your fire alarm/smoke detector at least once a month.



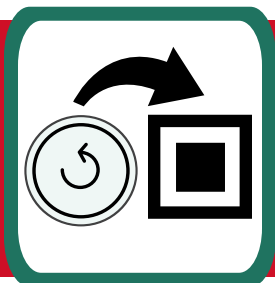
Vacuum around the smoke alarm vents with a soft brush every now and then.



Replace the batteries of your fire alarm/smoke detector every year.



Use a surface insect spray around the smoke alarm to prevent pests from nesting inside it.



Check the service life of the smoke detector/fire alarm. Replace them as recommended.
